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## **BRITISH COLUMBIA BEREAVEMENT CHECKLIST**

The death of a loved one is a difficult part of life; family members and those close to the deceased are often left to handle various administrative tasks which must take place. This checklist is a tool that can assist with identifying key federal departments and provincial ministries that should be notified of a death to terminate benefits and services or to initiate benefits for survivors.

Please note: An original or copy of a death certificate may be required; the requirements vary by program area.
